

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Mpumalanga and Limpopo Provinces. This is Big Game Country, the setting for dozens of sanctuaries teeming with wildlife and birds. Among them, the Kruger National Park is world renowned, as are several of the luxurious private reserves on its western boundary. The Kruger Park was established in 1898 to protect wildlife and covers an area of 2 million hectares. Truly the flagship of the South African national parks, Kruger is home to an impressive number of species: 336 trees, 49 fish, 34 amphibians, 114 reptiles, 507 birds and 147 mammals. Apart from the irresistible magnet of this wildlife mecca, some spectacular scenery can be viewed in the mountainous area known as the Panorama Route, en route to the Kruger Park.

Different packages are available as well as options between the different private – some very luxurious - lodges and Kruger National Park camps. Choose any combination to suit your need for comfort or your budget. Accommodation ranges from huts and safari tents to 5-star lodges.

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK PACKAGES

Two- to five-day packages are available. On these tours a tour guide accompanies the guests for the duration of the tour. On the three-day package, both nights are spent in the Kruger National Park and on the four-day package, you spend one night on the scenic Panorama Route with its waterfalls, forests and Gold Rush towns and two nights in the Kruger National Park. On the five-day package you spend two nights on the Panorama Route and two nights in the Kruger National Park.

PRIVATE GAME LODGE PACKAGES Some of these privately owned reserves are integrated with the world-famous Kruger National Park. The lodges cater for smaller groups, and day and night game drives are conducted in open vehicles by qualified game rangers and trackers. Accompanied game walks in the bush are also offered by most of the lodges. While enjoying a bushveld sunset, you are served sundowners, and when darkness sets in, spotlights are switched on for the night drive. Dinners are lamp-lit affairs in an open-air reed boma (shelter) under the star-studded African sky. Different packages are available from the following lodges:



Hamilton's Tented Camp

Hamilton's Tented Camp continues the safari tradition of a bygone era, incorporating comfort and luxury in the serenity of the African bush. This exclusive lodge in the world-renowned Kruger National Park has just 6 private luxury tents.

James Stevenson-Hamilton, the lodges namesake, left a legacy in his commitment to establishing the Kruger National Park in the same way a stay at Hamilton's Tented Camp, will remain etched in your memory for years to come. Reminiscent of an Out of Africa experience and resplendent with early 19th century nostalgia including old steamer trunks, pith helmets, antique bathroom basins and hurricane lanterns, Hamilton's is a tribute to the pioneers whose vision resulted in the conservation of one of Africa's prime wilderness areas.

Guests are accommodated in six exceptionally private luxury elevated tents overlooking the Nwaswitsontso River. From your own private deck, you can enjoy the sights and sounds of the bush that derives its existence from the river. The tents are nestled amongst the ancient Jackalberry and Sausage trees on the banks of the Nwatswitsonto River with exceptional views and the opportunity to witness spectacular sightings from these private settings.

Hoyo Hoyo Safari Lodge

The distinct thatched peaks peeping over the tree-line with hints of burnt orange flashing through lush Leadwood indicate your imminent arrival at Hoyo Hoyo Safari Lodge, set on the banks of the Mluwati River in the heart of the Kruger National Park.

The unique architecture is a celebration of the local Tsonga culture and integrates the rondavel rooms with splashes of tribal design and the earthy tones which define the interiors. The overall effect encapsulates the hearty spirit of warmth and welcoming that is so characteristic of the Tsonga people. Expect an authentic encounter with the local Tsonga culture in extraordinary bush surroundings.

When the sun has set, let the rhythm of the Shangaan ease, entertain, inspire and teach you. Sit on the deck surrounding the open-air fire and stare at the brilliant starry sky as you listen to a storyteller tell tales of local myths and legends. Imbali Safari Lodge

This exclusive lodge in the world-renowned Kruger National Park has just 12 private suites, each with their own private Jacuzzi or plunge pool. Each suite has a large king bed and romantic en-suite bathroom with magnificent views of the wilderness beyond. The sparkling swimming pool at the main lodge area promises a refreshing dip while providing the opportunity to enjoy the rich and varied wildlife that comes to the Imbali water hole for a cooling drink.

Meals are served in Imbali Safari Lodges comfortable dining room where an impressive Jackalberry tree rises through the deck and Tsonga-styled thatched roof. Dinner may be served under the stars while you listen to the enchanting sounds of the surrounding bush coming alive at night. Meals are also served in the privacy of the suite on request. Game drives are conducted on the private Mluwati Concession with access to the greater Kruger National Park.



Mjejane River Lodge

Mjejane River Lodge is perched on the banks of one of the Kruger National Park's greatest rivers - the Crocodile River - and is surrounded by tens of thousands of hectares of raw African wilderness. Set in the Southern Kruger region, east of

Malelane, the magnificent 3500 hectare Mjejane Game Reserve has been absorbed into the Kruger National Park and enjoys direct access to the Kruger over a private causeway. With over 14 km of Crocodile River frontage, Mjejane enjoys abundant wildlife and offers an outstanding Big 5 safari opportunity. The accommodation is comprised of fifteen executive rooms, each of which offers a spacious air conditioned haven of well-appointed comfort with a private veranda. As the African bush weaves its magic spell, your senses will awaken as never before and you will soak up a host of new experiences that will feed your soul.



Kruger Park Lodge – Hazyview

Your private bush snuggery within the Greater Kruger National Park, Geiger's Camp is the proud new addition to Motswari Private Game Reserve. Perched on a ridge with panoramic views of Big Five terrain, this luxury safari camp fuses tasteful elegance with historic, rustic charm.

The best way to experience the bush is to really slow down and closely observe your surroundings over time, so the game drives are three-and-a-half hours long in open Land Rovers, at sunrise and sunset, ensuring that you're treated to the loveliest scenes of nature and wildlife that the Timbavati has to offer. Sunsets in Africa are said to be like nowhere else on earth, so the sunset game drives which ease into the evening, are a must, not least because a vast cast of nocturnal wildlife takes the stage, including hyena, honey-badger, civet, bush babies and owls. Birdwatchers, meanwhile, will find a huge array of winged ones to tick off, as there are over 350 bird species to be spotted year-round.

Indlovu River Lodge - Greater Kruger National Park

The richly diverse 9000ha reserve hosts all of the Big Five species of Africa in a free roaming environment. With an abundance of general game species as well as extraordinary bird life you can expect to encounter a wide range of species on the game drives. Famed for regular leopard sightings, you are almost guaranteed to come across the Big Five during your stay.

Situated on the banks of the Kuvjenami river, lies 4 separate villas, accommodating a maximum of 20 guests. The villas are hidden under towering Jackalberry trees, with the magnificent northern escarpment of the Drakensberg mountains as a backdrop. Each villa has its own pool and boma, guaranteeing exclusivity and a private sense of being at home. Meals are privately served around the campfire in each villa's boma, which is ideal for families or small groups of like-minded people, who prefer their privacy.
